Rules & Regulations

- Students are to be present in school at <u>7:45 am</u> and to station themselves at their desk at <u>8:00 am</u>. The proctors will check on the students' attendance, and then start the exam.
- Students should be dressed appropriately in their <u>school uniform</u>.
 Failure to do so will result in the student's exam being canceled.
- All exams will be timed and will be collected when the allotted time ends even if the student has not completed the assessment.
- Students will only be allowed to attempt the exam once.
- Once completed, students can review/check their answers.
- Students joining the exam late will not be given extra time.
- Teachers will not be attending to any issues related to content. If a student comes across an issue with a question or a misprint, he/she should inform the proctor.

Rules & Regulations

Late arrivals:

Students are advised to be seated at their desks by <u>7:50 am</u> in their assigned room. No extra time will be given to any student unless a valid reason is given to the supervisors. Students who arrive after <u>8:10 am</u> will not be allowed to sit for their examination. A valid reason has to be submitted in order to schedule a make-up exam.

Absence:

In case of absence, the school office should be notified by the parents before **8:00 am**. If a student is absent without informing the school, he/she will be considered truant, and immediate action will be taken. An attested medical report has to be submitted from the parent of an absent student and presented to the supervisor before the student returns to school the following day.

Make-ups:

Only students with a valid excuse and who submit an attested medical report will be eligible for a make-up exam. Make-up exams will only be assigned once and if missed again without a valid reason, the student will be given a zero on the exam.

Breach of rules and misconduct during the exams

Any breach of rules or misconduct during the exam will result in the student being given a Zero. GIS follows a **Zero-tolerance Policy** when it comes to cheating during any assessment. This includes any of the following:

- Being in possession of any material in any form or shape, mobile phones, smart watches, equipment, notebooks, or other papers at any time during the assessment other than the student's device or those specified or authorized by the Teacher/Proctor.
- Contacting, communicating, talking to, or copying from any other student/source during the assessment or allowing work to be copied.
- Plagiarism is not tolerated. Common answers will grant all involved a zero on the related question.
- Any form of misbehavior during the assessment will lead to the <u>deduction of</u> <u>marks.</u>
- Proctors will <u>collect the exam papers of students</u> who are suspected with or caught cheating or not responding to instructions.
